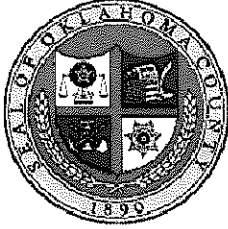


Nature of Claim: Damage to personal property (eyeglasses)



SUBJECT: Broken Glasses

On the above date and time I, DOI Stokes, was working in dayroom B at the Oklahoma County Juvenile Detention Center at 5905 N Classen Crt, Oklahoma City, OK when I heard an all available to dayroom D-4. Upon arriving in dayroom D-4 I went to the resident's room and witnessed DOI Brown and DOI Brison talking to resident Williams, Richard (OJA Nickelberry and Judge Kirby) and they were instructing him he was moving to dayroom B. I then entered the resident's room and tried to calm him down prior to him moving to dayroom B. The resident then became agitated and started to swing at staff. Upon seeing his action I immediately stepped in and restrained the resident using the proper CAPE technique. Due to his size and aggression, it took several staff to restrain him. In the process of securing the resident along with other staff, my glasses fell off of my face and were broken. SSII Cole secured the glasses until the incident was over. I am seeking compensation for my glasses in the amount of \$323.00; this is to include the frames, opti-thin lens, scratch resistance, polycarbonate I.O and transitional lens.
