



**SUBJECT: NOTICE OF INTENT TO CANCEL PROVISION OF FY2010
INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT – ALTERNATIVES TO
DETENTION/TRANSPORTATION**

Dear Commissioners,

Due to continued budget shortfalls declared by the State of Oklahoma, I regretfully find it necessary to cancel a **provision** in our current interagency agreement regarding the Alternatives to Detention/Transportation contract.

General Terms and Conditions; Paragraph R. Termination Due to Lack of Funding, states:

"OJA may terminate the Contract in the event that OJA is not granted funding to pay for the services herein described or in the event that funding is lost due to either a reduction in the budget or a reallocation of budgeted funds. Reallocation of budgeted funds is at the sole discretion of OJA. OJA shall notify Contractor of any such termination, by certified mail, return receipt requested, or in person with proof of delivery. The effective date of termination shall be specified in the notice."

Beginning February 1, 2010, the Office of Juvenile Affairs will no longer reimburse the county for **Own-Home Detention services**. This has been a valuable service for many years and we would like to thank you for your understanding during this budget crisis.
