***A PROCLAMATION WHEREBY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF OKLAHOMA COUNTY RECOGNIZES THE FORTY-FOURTH ANNUAL
FESTIVAL OF THE ARTS***

WHEREAS, the Forty-Fourth Annual Festival of the Arts, sponsored by the Arts Council of Oklahoma City, will officially open on Tuesday, April 20, 2010, for six days of exciting visual and performing arts activities; and

WHEREAS, the Festival of the Arts is recognized nationally as one of the most spectacular fine arts events in America, featuring more than 170 visual artists, continuous live entertainment on four outdoor stages, art activities for all ages, and delicious Festival foods; and

WHEREAS, the 2010 Festival co-chairs, Sandra Cassimus and John Robberson, lead a team of more than 5,000 volunteers who donate their time, talents, resources and energies to produce a spectacular celebration of the Arts of the City of Oklahoma City; and

WHEREAS, the Festival of the Arts is an event which is free to the public and made possible through the generous support of civic and business leaders as well as individuals who embrace the Arts each spring. This support produces an event from which proceeds allow the Arts Council of Oklahoma City to continue to expand opportunity including arts programming, arts education programs and cultural arts facilities for the citizens of Oklahoma City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners do hereby proclaim April 20-25, 2010, as "FORTY-FOURTH ANNUAL FESTIVAL OF THE ARTS WEEK" in the City of Oklahoma City and ask all citizens to join in honoring the Arts Council of Oklahoma City, the volunteers and the artists who take part in this event.
