RESOLUTION FOR THE SECOND ANNUAL COUNTY GOLF TOURNAMENT TO SUPPORT THE FIRST TEE OF METROPOLITAN OKLAHOMA CITY

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Youth Development and Education Foundation Inc., was established to implement The First Tee of Metropolitan Oklahoma City; and

WHEREAS, after closing in the mid 1980's, the Eastern Golf Course re-opened in 1997 due to the efforts of then Councilwoman Willa Johnson. Councilwoman Johnson secured a small city appropriation and donated goods and services resulting in the construction of the driving range; and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Course was renamed for James E. Stewart, honoring a long time northeast Oklahoma City community leader and Oklahoma City Golf Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, in 2001 Tiger Woods came to Oklahoma City and conducted a junior clinic at the James E. Stewart Golf Course to show his support for the fledgling First Tee organization; and

WHEREAS, The First Tee helps kids in establishing nine core values that are inherently positive and connected with the game of golf, including: honesty, integrity, sportsmanship, respect, confidence, responsibility, perseverance, courtesy and judgment; and

WHEREAS, the mission of The First Tee of Metropolitan Oklahoma City is to impact the lives of young people by providing learning facilities and educational programs that promote character development and life-enhancing values through the game of golf; and

WHEREAS, The County First Tee Spring Roundup will be hosted by Commissioner Willa Johnson at Twin Hills Country Club, Tuesday, May 25, 2010, at 1:30 p.m. Teams for this small fund raiser will be made up of County employees, their friends and family and will generate funds for the First Tee and not compete with nor compromise its big event; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Oklahoma County hereby pledge its support and grants permission to Commissioner Willa Johnson, and Oklahoma County Employees to disseminate information and promote the Second Annual County Spring Roundup Golf Tournament to be held on Tuesday May 25, 2010.
