<p>OAC 310:670</p>	<p>FACILITY DOES NOT MEET OKLAHOMA JAIL STANDARDS AS EVIDENCED BY:</p> <p>Adequate medical care shall be provided in a facility. The Administrator shall develop and implement written policies and procedures for complete emergency medical and health care services. Policies and procedures shall include at least the following: (2) Medical triage screening shall be performed on all prisoners immediately upon admission to the facility and before being placed in the general population or housing area. Those individuals who appear to have a significant medical or psychiatric problem, or who may be a suicide risk, shall be transported to the supporting medical facility as soon as possible, They shall be housed separately in a location where they can be observed frequently by the staff at least until the appropriate medical evaluation has been completed. If after stringent evaluation the highest-ranking mental health professional, in conjunction with a senior detention supervisor, these prisoners may be authorized to share the same cell.
