

# PENDING APPROVAL

RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_

WHEREAS, Oklahoma Statutes, Title 19 §§ 180.71 to 180.75 provide that the Board of Oklahoma County Commissioners shall have the authority to set the salary of the Oklahoma County elected officials as directed in an open meeting and duly entered in the minutes of said meeting at the time an ad valorem valuation has been certified; and,

WHEREAS, 19 O. S. § 180.75 provides the salary of all county officers subject to the above referenced statutes may be increased from the applicable basic salary, but only according to the provisions of the Statutes and scale established in § 180.75; and,

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 2573 amending 19 O.S. § 180.75, taking effect November 1, 2010, changes the “may” to “shall” with relation to the increase of county officer salaries from the applicable basic salary ; and,

WHEREAS, the officers of Oklahoma County do not recommend a salary increase pursuant to the above-referenced statute in its current form or as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners for Oklahoma County hereby authorizes and directs that each elected official, including the county treasurer, county clerk, county assessor, court clerk, county sheriff, and each commissioner, shall have the applicable basic salary reduced so as to offset any mandatory, statutory increase, in order to maintain current salary levels established last fiscal year according to the applicable statutory provisions.
