**Commissioner Roth Presents Forest Park with Fire Equipment**

District One Commissioner Jim Roth presented Forest Park Fire Department with a new fire truck.

The County, which is statutorily involved in the creation of fire protection districts for rural parts of Oklahoma County, has traditionally assisted smaller jurisdictions with equipment donations. These partnerships help create mutual cooperation and enhanced fire protection for all citizens.

The brush pumper fire truck is designed and equipped to handle small fires and grass fires. The truck is ideal with its exceptional ability to maneuver through rough terrain and wooded areas.

Commissioner Roth stated “it is always good to have an opportunity to work with our cities and towns in District One. Our cities and towns often have big needs but little dollars nor the tax base to support community requests. This is a great example of tax dollars at work for the safety of our citizens.

The City of Choctaw is scheduled to receive fire equipment in 2004.

As Commissioner Roth approaches his one year anniversary since taking the oath of office, District One is on a historical path of accomplishments.
