The City of Choctaw has filed a resolution calling a special election for November 18, 2025 to consider the following propositions:

PROPOSITION 1

Shall a proposed amendment of the City Charter, CREATING ARTICLE B, SECTION 2-18 to read as follows:

“The term of office for Mayor and City Council shall be three terms of four years, respectively. After serving three terms of four years, the public official will not be eligible for consideration for election to an additional term, but shall be eligible to continue to serve as a carry over officer until a replacement is elected and qualified. Additionally, the officer may be appointed in the case of a future vacancy to carry out an unexpired term. A public officer shall be eligible to serve three terms of four years on the City Council, and additionally eligible to serve three terms of four years as Mayor. Time on the City Council and served as Mayor prior to the effective date of this provision shall not be applicable after the adoption of this provision.”

PROPOSITION 2

Shall the following municipal proposition be approved or rejected:

“The City of Choctaw is hereby authorized to sell the property currently operated as Optimist Park in accordance with applicable law.”
