The City of Edmond has filed a resolution calling a special election for November 18, 2025 to consider the following propositions:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall City of Edmond Ordinance No. 4054 be approved, which does not increase Edmond sales taxes, but authorizes an extension of an existing one percent (1.0%) City of Edmond General Purpose Sales Tax which was originally approved by the voters on April 5, 1977 (and reapproved by the voters in 1986, 1996, 2006, and 2016) such extension to be for an additional ten years and eleven days with such one percent tax to terminate on March 31, 2037, unless otherwise extended?

PROPOSITION NO. 2

Shall City of Edmond Ordinance No. 4055 be approved, which does not increase Edmond sales taxes, but authorizes an extension of and change of purpose of the existing one-half of one percent (0.50%) City of Edmond Sales Tax, commonly known as the Public Safety Center Sales Tax, which was originally approved by the voters on October 11, 2011 (and reapproved by the voters in 2016); providing the purpose of the existing Public Safety Center Sales Tax will remain until March 31, 2027, and the extension and new purpose thereof shall commence on April 1, 2027, and end March 31, 2037, with all revenues to be deposited to a special capital improvement fund to be used, with or without other funds, for the purpose of providing capital improvements in the form of street repairs and improvements for the City as recommended by the Capital Improvement Projects Advisory Board and as determined by the City Council as provided in said Ordinance?
