### FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Friday, May 22, 2026, is the last day to apply for voter registration to be eligible to vote in June 16, 2026, Primary Elections.

Persons who are United States citizens, residents of Oklahoma and at least 17 1/2 years old are eligible to apply for voter registration. However, you must be at least 18 years old to vote.

People who have never been registered to vote before or who are not currently registered in the county of their residence will need to complete a new Voter Registration Application to be eligible to vote. People who have moved within the county and need to update their address may make changes online using the OK Voter Portal at [oklahoma.gov/elections/ovp](https://oklahoma.gov/elections/ovp) or complete a Voter Registration Application.

Applications postmarked after May 22, 2026, will still be accepted, but will not be processed until after the June 16, 2026, Election. **Change of political affiliation is prohibited until September 1.**

The County Election Board will respond in writing to each person who applies for voter registration. The response will be either a Voter Identification Card listing the new voter's precinct number and polling location or a letter that explains the reason or reasons the application for voter registration was not approved. Any person who has submitted a voter
