Meeting Minutes

Call to Order at 7:02pm by Jeff Parker

1. Minutes

Megan Marshall made the motion to approve the last meetings minutes. Austyn Fuss seconded the motion. All approved.

2. Treasurer Report

Jessica Clayton provided the current budget from the county and Jeff Parker gave the current Treasurer Report. Austyn Fuss made the motion to approve the Treasurer Report, JT Langston seconded the motion, All approved.
